DAY 01 KUALA LUMPUR □ CHRISTCHURCH

(MOB)

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your flight to Christchurch.

DAY 02 CHRISTCHURCH ~ CITY TOUR

(MOB/CHD)

On arrival proceed for your Christchurch City Tour. Drive through acres of well-kept parklands, gothic-style buildings and Elizabethan mansions, and discover why this city is also called "the most English city outside England". Passing through the Avon River and stop at the rugged Cashmere Hills where you can catch a view of Christchurch city. If time permits, stop at the Canterbury Museum for the historical side of Christchurch.

DAY 03 CHRISTCHURCH ~ LAKE TEKAPO ~ MT. COOK ~ MRS JONES FRUIT ORCHARD ~QUEENSTOWN

(B/BBQL/CHD)

Travel through the Canterbury Plains, over Burke Pass, into the McKenzie Country. Stop at the Church Of The Good Shepherd, a small memorial set against a spectacular backdrop of snow capped mountains and turquoise waters of the lovely glacier-fed Lake Tekapo. Next, proceed to Lake Pukaki for a clear view of Mount Cook, also known as "Aorangi" or "The Cloud Piercer". If weather permits, take an optional helicopter flight up to the Tasman Glacier and experience the thrill of landing on a sparkling white snowfield. Moving on to Kawarau Gorge, make a brief stop at Mrs. Jones Fruit Orchard to purchase some fruits. In the evening, reach the major resort town of Queenstown, nestled beside the deep blue waters of Lake Wakatipu.

DAY 04 QUEENSTOWN ~ MILFORD SOUND ~ TE ANAU

(B/Japanese L/CHD)

The journey begins across the Kawarau Dam and along the southern arm of Lake Wakatipu to Kingston. Admire the wonderful scenery around you as you cut through the beech-forest of Eglinton Valley. Along the way, stop at spots of great scenic beauty. Later, reach the World Heritage Site of Milford Sound - the eighth natural wonder of the world. During your cruise into the deep blue waterways of the fiordland, be awed by the grandeur of sheer rocky slopes rising dramatically out of the icy cold waters, against a stunning backdrop of snowy peaks. Take in the breathtaking sights while you lunch onboard the cruise. Next, proceed to Te Anau for your overnight accommodation.

DAY 05 TE ANAU ~ DUNEDIN

(B/CHL/CHD)

After breakfast, travel across Lake Te Anau to explore the Te Anau Glow Worm Caves. Board a boat and be taken on an underground adventure alongside thundering streams and above cascading waterfalls. Glide through the silent darkness of the glowworm grotto and be greeted by the sight of glowworms illuminating the darkness. Thereafter, take a drive through the towns of Lumsden, Gore and Balclutha, before arriving at Dunedin. This university city of Scottish heritage has a population of 120,000. On your Dunedin City Tour, you will be shown the city's architectural treasures, which include gothic-styled churches with soaring cathedral spires, the renowned Otago University, the famous Octagon and the magnificent Flemish style railway station.!

DAY 06 DUNEDIN ~ MOERAKI BOULDERS ~ CHRISTCHURCH □ WELLINGTON (B/CHL/CHD)

This morning, travel up North, passing through the townships of Timaru and Oamaru. Make a stop at the famous Moeraki Boulders, which according to Maori tradition, the spherical boulders are gourds and calabashes washed from the great voyaging canoe Araiteuru when it was wrecked upon landfall in New Zealand some 1,000 years ago. Proceed on with your journey and enjoy your scenic drive back to Christchurch and take domestic flight to Wellington, the capital city of New Zealand. Your Wellington city tour and discover this compact city, full of political history, cultured and character. See the old Government Buildings; one of the oldest wooden structures south of the equator. If time permitted, travel up to Mt. Victoria, undoubtedly the capital's city's favorite's lookout, for its spectacular bird's-eye view of the city and surrounds.

DAY 07 WELLINGTON ~ TAUPO ~ ROTORUA (B/CHL/Hangi D)

This morning, We travel north through the Tongariro National Park, dominated by huge, active volcanoes and arrive at Lake Taupo. Visit the mighty Huka Falls and Wairakei Geothermal Power Station before arriving into Rotorua. Tour starts with visit to Rainbow Spring. Here, you will find numerous beautiful native trees and streams, and a huge variety of New Zealand's most precious inhabitants. Then proceed to Agrodome, where a stage show features 19 breeds of sheep on displays and the amazing sheepdogs does their stunts. Tonight be treated to the ultimate Rotorua Experience - A traditional Hangi Feast cooked in the steam boxes and hot water pool. Spend a delightful evening entertainment of Maori Concert, giving you an insight of the unique and fascinating Maori culture and folklore.

DAY 08 ROTORUA ~ AUCKLAND ~ City Tour (B/CHL/Farewell D)

This morning, visit to a natural wonderland of bubbling mud pools, erupting geysers and steaming hot springs at the Te Puia Thermal Reserve. Also, you can catch a glimpse of the Polynesian culture at the displays of Maori carving and flax weaving. Thereafter, continue your idyllic drive through lush green pastures into Auckland. Your Auckland City Tour takes you through this cosmopolitan city, which is also known as the "City of Sails". To fully appreciate the unique setting of Auckland, Make a stop as well to catch the best angles of the Auckland Harbour Bridge, one of the city's most distinctive landmarks. Tonight, enjoy a dining experience with magnificent view of Auckland at Sky Tower The Observatory restaurant. The unique combination of sumptuous brasserie-style buffet with stunning seafood specialties awaits you! After dinner, journey to Sky Deck and discover the highest views in Auckland.
